

ARTICLE 1V - BOARD OF DIRECTORS

4.1. Number, Qualifications, Powers

4.1.1. The property, affairs, and business of the Chapter shall be managed and controlled by its Board of Directors. The Board of Directors may by general resolution delegate to officers of the Chapter such powers as are provided for in these By-Laws,

4.1.2. The Board of Directors (sometimes referred to as the "board" and individual members thereof referred to as "director" or "directors") shall consist of the individuals currently serving as the President, the President-Elect, the Secretary, the Treasurer, the Immediate Past President, and two Directors-at-Large.

4.1.3. To be eligible for election as a director, an individual must be a Regular or Distinguished Life member and must have been such a member for one (1) year as of the date of the meeting at which the results of the election are to be announced. No individual may hold more than one Directorship at any time nor have served as national president.

4.1.4. To be eligible for election as President-Elect, the individual must have served on the Board of Directors for one year or served as a committee chair for one year.

4.1.5. To be eligible for election as Secretary, Treasurer, or Director-at-Large, the individual must have served on a chapter committee for one year.

4.2. Election and Term. All directors shall commence their terms of office on September 1.

4.2.1. The President, President-Elect, Secretary, Treasurer and Immediate Past President shall serve as directors by virtue of the office he or she holds. These directors shall serve until they no longer hold their respective offices.

4.2.2. The President-Elect shall be elected at large, shall serve in that office for one (1) year, and shall automatically assume the office of President in the subsequent year. At the end of his/her term as President, the individual shall automatically remain on the Board of Directors for a one-year term as Immediate Past President.

4.2.3. The Secretary shall be elected at large for a two-year term and shall be elected in even-numbered years. Term limit shall be two consecutive two-year terms.

4.2.4. The Treasurer shall be elected at large for a two-year term and shall be elected in odd-numbered years. Term limit shall be two consecutive two-year terms.

4.2.5. Directors-at-Large shall be elected for one-year terms. Term limit shall be two consecutive one-year terms.
